- Essential information to be included in each Timeline
 - Exact dates and names of people and/or events
 - Scale by which the information is laid out
 - Key to your scale that you used
 - Beginning date should be 2000 BC/includes before that date
 - Ending date is to present day
- A good heading
- Clear/neat handwriting
