1. Adopt Minutes from April 27th, 2006 regularly scheduled meeting. Motion to approve minutes by Cheri, seconded, by Vickie; adopted.
  
2. School Board Report:  
We have a total of 25 applicants for next year. Ten 8<sup>th</sup> graders are graduating, three 7<sup>th</sup> graders are leaving our program, this leaves 13 slots open for new students for the next school year. We accepted the three remaining students on last year's waiting list, then accepted ten students from the April applicants. Due to the enrollment cap of 44 students, we will not be able to accommodate 15 of the new applicants. They have been placed on the 2006-2007 waiting list.
